as arts funding gets levelled up

英国国家歌剧院总部搬离伦敦

英国国家歌剧院将把总部搬到伦敦以外的地方,并大幅削减预算,这是英国政府计划 对国内艺术机构经费进行重大调整的一部分。

Over recent years, English National Opera has received around 12 million pounds a year from the Arts Council – around twice what it gets in **box office receipts**.

Next year, it's off the list. It will be offered a **transitional grant** of 17 million pounds to help it **reorganise** and create a base out of London, possibly Manchester.
